Volunteers are provided with training and the equipment needed to safely watch for suspicious activity, persons or vehicles and to report what they see to the RCMP.

Our volunteers NEVER become involved in an incident. Safety and security of our volunteers is paramount.

For the protection of our volunteers, the privacy of those who wish to remain anonymous is protected.



Application Process

Step 1— Deliver the completed application section of this form to the Morinville RCMP detachment.

OR

Forward your name and contact information (as requested in the application portion of this brochure) to us by e-mail at cop@morinvillecop.org and one of our Executive will contact you.

Step 2- Complete an interview with Morinville C.O.P. executive members.

Step 3- Complete a free RCMP Police Information Check.

Step 4 - Join as a probationary member and begin your training.

Frequently Asked Questions

How much time does this take?

A suggested minimum of 1 patrol and 1 meeting / training session per month; approx. 6 hours per month. We also welcome any volunteer time to assist us with organization of public presentations and/or assist with other activities such as the Morinville Chamber of Commerce trade fair.

What do you do?

A volunteer team of two members, using its own vehicle, on foot, or even on bicycle, patrols the Town and reports any unusual or suspicious activity to R.C.M.P officers on duty.

When do you patrol?

The key times are between 9:00p.m. and 5:00a.m. but actual patrol times are left up to each volunteer .

What if you see unlawful activity?

We follow protocol and our training; we report the incident to the RCMP from a safe distance.

What areas are patrolled? All residential, recreational, commercial and industrial areas of Morinville and Cardiff.

Can I be anonymous to the public? Yes. You are not required to display your MCOP affiliation.

How can I help?

If you 18 or older, of good character and able to pass the Police Information Check, contact us via email or complete this form and drop it off at the Morinville RCMP detachment. One of our Executive will contact you shortly.

Who We Are

Morinville C.O.P. is a Community Policing Program which works in partnership with the Morinville R.C.M.P. We have served the citizens of Morinville and Cardiff for over 15 years.

What We Do

We provide assistance to the R.C.M.P. and to the Town by patrolling by vehicle, bicycle, or on foot and reporting suspicious activities or potentially unsafe conditions. Our group acts as an extra set of eyes and ears to the police.

We also provide programs such as Crime Prevention Awareness Presentations and Vehicle Speed Education Sessions.

Morinville C.O.P. patrols are not designed to replace the regular police patrols, but to enhance them by being out there ourselves and looking for suspicious or criminal activity. "Strength in numbers" Our role is to observe and report and we leave it to the professionals to investigate and to act.

Our Results

Our volunteers have reported:

- Suspicious people or vehicles
- Acts of Vandalism
- Impaired or Dangerous driving
- Disorderly Conduct

Our volunteers have also checked the speed of thousands of vehicles and handed out hundreds of theft awareness tickets.
